Help for Tameside residents in financial difficulty

If you are in financial difficulty there are options and alternative sources of help and support for Tameside residents.

If you have been sanctioned, or have been refused benefits

If your benefits are delayed

Short Term Benefit Advances

If you are waiting for Jobseekers Allowance, Income Support, Carers Allowance, Employment and Support Allowance or Universal Credit, you may be able to get a **Short Term Benefit Advance** payment. You need to be able to demonstrate that you are in financial need whilst waiting for your benefit to be paid. Any payment you get will have to be repaid later.

Use the complaints procedure

If you have claimed a benefit and you have yet to receive a decision on your claim, first check with the Department for Work & Pensions (DWP) that they have all of the information they need to make their decision. If they have, and you feel you have been waiting too long for a decision, making a formal complaint to the DWP can sometimes help speed things up. Contact details will be at the top of any letters sent from Jobcentre Plus and they should try to resolve the issue over the phone or deal with your complaint

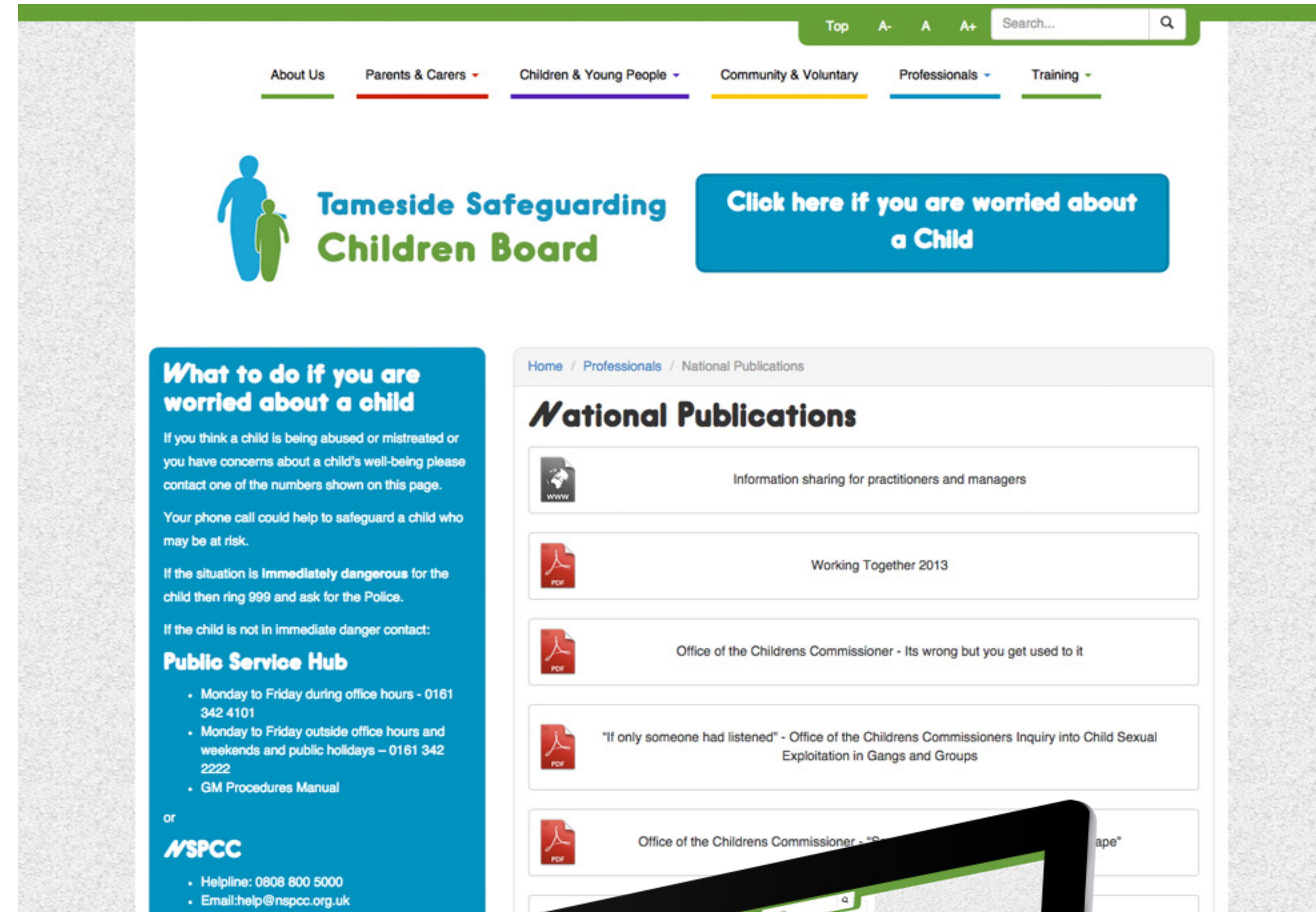
